**About Alta-1 College QLD**

Alta-1 College QLD is a co-educational, independent Christian, Special Assistance School. The first campus of the Queensland college is located in the suburb of Caboolture, approximately 50km north of the Brisbane CBD. Alta-1 is a college specifically designed to provide alternative education to disadvantaged and at-risk young people.

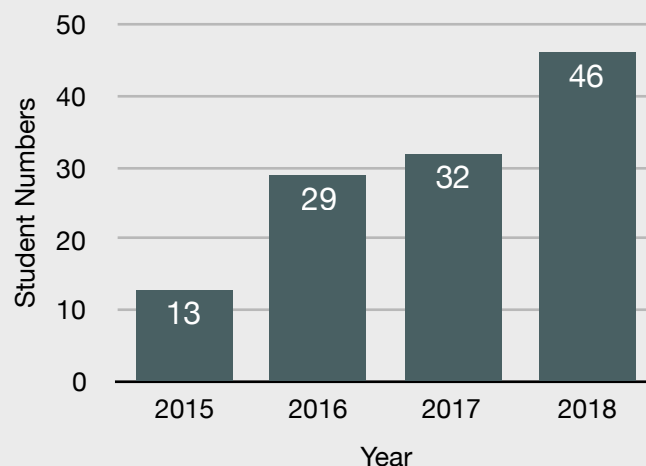
During the 2018 school year, Alta-1 College QLD provided educational programs for “at-risk” senior school students aged from 15 to 19. The educational offering of the college included Year 11 and 12 courses, leading towards the Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE), and a personal development course that assists students to address personal issues that negatively impact learning. Educational programs also included courses for housebound senior students through the ConnectEd Program.

**Student Attendance**

- In 2018, the average student attendance rate was 53.5%
- In context, many students of the college have had difficulties attending school prior to coming to Alta-1. Most students of the college see an increase in their school attendance while at Alta-1.
- Student absences are followed up with parent/guardian notifications via telephone, voice message or SMS by approximately 11:30am each day.

**Student Numbers**

46 students were enrolled at the time of the 2018 Federal Census.



**Student Outcomes and Post-College Destinations**

3 students attained a Year 12 certificate in 2018. This represented 37.5% of the Year 12 cohort. 50% of the Year 12 cohort undertook Vocational Education and Training (VET) courses.

Post school destinations included; full and part-time employment, enrolment in TAFE and engagement with other Registered Training Organisations. Some students destinations are unknown.

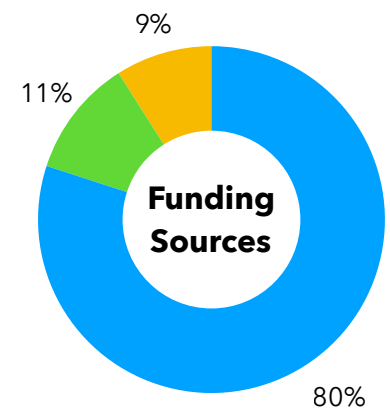
